Course Material: Seek ilm Quranic Tafsir Lecture Notes, Qasas an-Nabiyyin

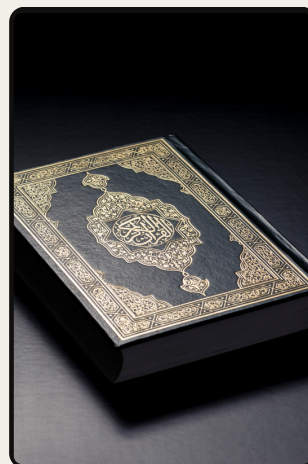
